



CURTAINS

Curtains are a popular choice in many homes for practical and decorative reasons. Consumers can choose from light chiffon, to heavy, luxurious fabrics; from plain linen to those with prints- the possibilities are endless! The only decision to make is to be very sure of the theme of your home.

As curtains do not hold any shape of their own, the undulation of the fabric is created through the spacing of carriers and tapes on the curtain tracks. In the event if a curtain shape is required, common ones would be ripple fold and pinch pleat.

While curtains dramatically beautify any space, they can be cumbersome to close because of the friction between fabric, weight and rail. Also, drawing them can be a hassle especially if you are in a rush. Enter Somfy curtain motors.

Common types of curtains are:

1) DAY CURTAINS

Day curtains are normally made of lightweight fabrics such as organza or lace. They add a soft and soothing touch to your room. If you are a fan of having natural light at home without the intense glare from the sun- day curtains are for you.

2) NIGHT CURTAINS

Night curtains are normally paired with day curtains. In tropical households, a 'night curtain' is referred to a curtain made mainly from linen or cotton. When drawn, it shields the home from the sun and offers more privacy than day curtains.

3) BLACKOUT CURTAINS

Blackout Curtains are made from very opaque fabrics meant to block off the slightest ray of light- ideal for those who appreciate sleeping in total darkness. These curtains can be found in hotel rooms.

BLINDS

Window blinds first made their entrance with flimsy slats that get lopsided and stuck every now and then. Also, who could forget cords that would tangle, turn brown and break as time passes.

These shades have since dropped their chords and slats, and now come in fun and rich fabrics. **The best blinds of today are paired with Somfy motorswhich allows coverings to move without anyone having to lift a finger.**

Common types of blinds are:



1) ROLLER BLINDS

Roller Blinds are cost-effective and are a breeze to clean. From opaque to semi-transparent- these fabrics come with a myriad of choices to meet the privacy needs of every household.

2) ROMAN BLINDS

Roman Blinds are a type of window blind made of a fabric that is segmented into large pleats. They come with mechanisms to draw the pleats up into sections. Roman blinds provide a softer look as compared to roller blinds and venetian blinds.

3) VENETIAN BLINDS

Venetian Blinds are made of horizontal slats which can be rotated, raised or lowered to allow as much light as possible. Somfy controls and apps provide users with the freedom to tilt their slats easily and remotely.

4) ZEBRA BLINDS

Zebra blinds allow you to transition between sheer and privacy. The blinds can be adjusted so that the "stripes" offer privacy, light control and insulation.






WIREFREE



AWNINGS



Most awnings come in 2 styles:



1) FOLDING ARM AWNING

2) FULL-CASSETTE AWNING

A fully concealed cassette awning is an enclosed awning where the roller, fabric and arms are completely protected and stored in a closed cassette when retracted.



PEGOLAS

Pergolas are transforming our backyards into outdoor rooms. They are popular hangouts for entertaining guests, and are also structurally stronger than awnings, because of their architecture.







These technologies have been embedded in Somfy motors to ensure great user-experiences, and energy efficiency. Radio Technology Somfy® (RTS) is Somfy's exclusive control platform which enables users to adjust motorized interior window coverings and motorized exterior products such as awnings, rolling shutters, pergolas and screens from virtually anywhere inside or outside the home. RTS allows users to enter a world of solutions designed to create ambiance and bring creations to life to provide the ultimate combination of luxury and performance effortlessly! A simple press of a button on a remote control or wireless wall switch sends out a radio wave signal to move any motorized interior or exterior window coverings with ease. There is no need to point or aim the transmitter because RTS is omnidirectional and operates within a range of up to 65 feet. And just like a garage door opener, the radio waves travel through walls, making control of motorized products easier than ever.

The Somfy Digital Network (SDN) is a generation of bus-line enabled Intelligent Tubular Motors and Smart Switch Controls. The SDN components are integrated into a cost effective system designed to operate a wide range of end products such as solar screens, projection screens and Venetian blinds over a standard RS-485 network. It is a standard half duplex, bi-directional RS-485 network. Bi-directional communications makes it possible to receive feedback from each motor on the network. This allows the system to view the position and status of any motor on the network, in real time. Since the SDN network runs over standard network architecture, it is possible to establish a remote connection to the system from anywhere internet access is available. This defines a new level of commissioning and support services that can be offered for today's energy efficient Intelligent Building.
